

Basic Scaffolding Inspection and Appreciation Course

Aim

The aim of the course is to enable delegates to acquire the skills and knowledge needed to erect, and work safely from, tower scaffolding in the workplace. Delegates will be made aware of current legislation, safety and inspection requirements and hazards that occur in the workplace.

Course Content

- Health and Safety at Work Act Construction (Design and Management) Regulations (CDM)
- Proposed Construction (Health, Safety and Welfare) Regulations Risk Assessment Provision and Use of Work Equipment Construction (Working Places) Regulations
- Definition of terms
- Tubes, fittings, types of uses and inspecting
- Boards, types, use, inspecting
- Construction and layout and independent scaffolds, putlock, towers, mobile, static, proprietary (i.e. cuplock type)
- Ties: types, uses and method of fixing
- Suspended scaffold and birdcages
- Cantilever, overhangs, aprons, netting, etc
- Prevention of falls
- Protection of the public and the prevention of falling materials, etc
- Inspection procedure, initial, weekly record keeping (F.91)
- Practical inspection scaffold
- Site safety and course discussion
- Assessment
