Fork Lift Truck (Basic Operator Training)

Aim

This practical course is designed for prospective fork lift truck (FLT) operators who have little or no experience. The course is approved by the Road Transport Industry Training Board Ltd and fully complies with approved Code of Practice and Guidance for the Rider-Operated Lift Trucks Operator Training 1999 2nd Edition (L117), PUWER 1998 and LOLER 1998.

The aim of the course is to enable participants to acquire the skills and knowledge needed to operate fork lift trucks, reach, counterbalance or pedestrian, safely and efficiently and to take the Joint Committee Industry Training Board (JCITB) skill test.

Course Content

- The Health and Safety at Work Act
- FLT operators' safety codes
- Daily checks and FLT maintenance
- Manoeuvring in open and confined spaces
- Stacking and de-stacking pallets of various heights
- Lorry bed loading
- Practical and theory test

Duration: 5 days

Fork Lift Truck Driving (3-day course for experienced operators)

Aim

This practical course is designed for existing forklift truck (FLT) operators who have been continuously operating FLT's for a minimum of six months. The course is approved by the Road Transport Industry Training Board Ltd and fully complies with the Approved Code of Practice and Guidance for the Rider-Operated Lift Trucks Operator Training 1999 2nd Edition (L117), PUWER 1998 and LOLER 1998.

To enable participants to acquire the skills and knowledge needed to operate fork lift trucks, reach, counterbalance or pedestrian, safely and efficiently and to take the RTITB assessment and skill test.

- Stacking and de-stacking pallets at varying heights
- Practical and theory test

Fork Lift Truck Driving (Refresher/Re-certification)

Aim

FLT operators are recommended to attend this course at three year intervals. The course is approved by the Road Transport Industry Training Board Ltd and fully complies with the Approved Code of Practice and Guidance for the Rider-Operated Lift Trucks Operator Training 1999 2nd Edition (L117), PUWER 1998 and LOLER 1998.

To remind participants of the need for, and methods of, correct and safe operation of Fork Lift Trucks, reach, counterbalance or pedestrian, and to re-take the RTITB Assessment and skill test.
